

Delta Kappa Gamma Theta Alpha Chapter Minutes August 20, 2016

The regular meeting of the Theta Alpha chapter of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International was called to order at 10:00 am by Mary Myers, President in Dallas at Arcadia Park Branch of the Dallas Public Library. Sandra King, Recording Secretary, led the inspiration with a selection of humorous student comments submitted by teachers to Reader's Digest magazine. A Members Update was given on those who were unable to attend. A quorum was reached with 20 members in attendance. The May minutes were approved with corrections.

Marilyn Bishop, Co-Treasurer, presented the chapter's budget for the year. The chapter's ending balance as of June 30, 2016 was \$2062.12. Baudalia Luna, Co-Treasurer, reported on dues for the year and that full payment was needed by October. Diane McCorcle made a motion to approve the budget for the year. The motion for the budget passed unanimously.

Sandra King read correspondence. This included a Thank You from Pam Herrigar, Nu Gamma President, and Elizabeth Knott, Nu Gamma Secretary, for the monetary donation made to their chapter. Terri Hahn, Catering Manager for The Adolphus, sent a Thank You to the chapter for holding its 50th Anniversary Tea at the hotel.

Mary Myers reported that at the July 28th, 2016 Executive Board Meeting that it was decided to have refreshments at the beginning of the chapter meetings rather than afterwards. Members were in agreement with the decision.

Mary reminded everyone about the upcoming Area Nine Workshop in Ennis on September 17th, 2016 and that Cathy Criner, Area Nine Coordinator, needed the chapter to provide a \$25 gift card and a fruit tray. There was discussion about members carpooling and it was left up to individual members to make arrangements on their own. Baudalia Luna announced that the chapter would have a vendor's table at the workshop and volunteers were needed to work at the table. The chapter will be offering acrylic angel and snowman

ornaments and jar openers for sale.

This year the Coordinating Council of Dallas County's Luncheon will be held on April 1, 2017 at 10 am. Mary Myers announced that the chapter would be in charge of checking in attendees.

Jan Gentry pointed out that her name was listed under two different Greek Families. Ruth Kahn explained what happened and Jan was removed from one of the families.

Committee chairs reported on their committees. Catie King and Leslie Valentincic, Co-First Vice Presidents, presented the programs and projects for the year. Linda Robards, Membership Committee Chair explained different ways to encourage current members to attend meetings. She announced the goal for this year is for each current member to nominate one person for membership in the chapter and that the prospect cards would be used again this year. Patti Belknap, Parliamentarian, expressed concern since of the nine new members initiated in April 2016 only two were in attendance. A discussion followed, addressing ways to keep in contact with current members and eligibility to join. Sarah McMurrough, T.H.A.T. Scholarship Committee Chair, reported that the chapter has already received a scholarship application. After discussion the deadline to receive applications was changed to September 17, 2016. Members may bring completed applications to give to Sarah at the Area Nine Workshop. Hattie Hammer, Legislature News Committee Chair provided an update on the Texas Retired Teachers Association (TRTA) Pension Fund. Eligible chapter members were encouraged to join TRTA.

Awards the chapter received at the State Convention were on display for members to view. Mary Myers thanked the Gamma Family for providing refreshments. Three door prizes were given out by Catie King and Leslie Valentincic.

The meeting adjourned at 11:36 am with the singing of the DKG song.
